## The CBC Annual Summer Member Appreciation Party!

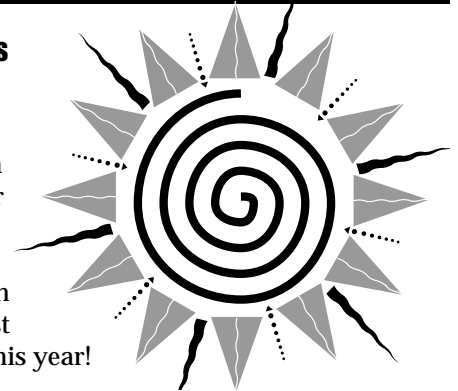
**A CBC tradition we all look forward to is

## CBC Board Director Vacancies

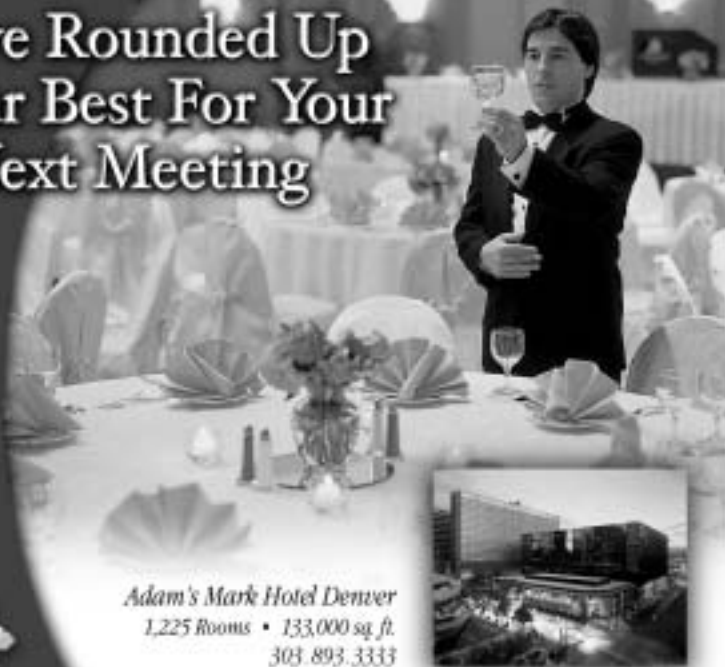
